

SOLICITATION FOR TREATMENT SERVICES PROVIDERS FOR THE PERIOD OCTOBER 1, 2017 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2018

Deadline for letters of interest is noon on Thursday, August 31, 2017

The United States Probation and Pretrial Services Office for the Northern District of West Virginia will be soliciting treatment services for federal defendants and offenders through the issuance of Blanket Purchase Agreements, Competitive Purchase Orders, and/or Non-Competitive Purchase Orders for the period beginning October 1, 2017 and ending September 30, 2018. Required treatment services may include urine collection, substance abuse, and mental health treatment. **Providers will be required to demonstrate their ability to avail their services within a 15-mile radius of Clarksburg, WV.**

Interested treatment providers must respond timely to solicitation deadlines and clearly show that (1) they can provide services, (2) such services will be provided by certified, licensed professionals with experience in such treatment, and (3) prices of such treatment shall be as low as or lower than those charged to the treatment provider's most favored customer for comparable quantities under similar terms and conditions.
