PRE-SOLICITATION FOR TREATMENT SERVICES

Deadline for letters of interest is noon on Tuesday, October 13, 2020

The United States Probation and Pretrial Services Office for the Northern District of West Virginia will be soliciting treatment services for federal defendants and offenders participating in the Wheeling, WV Drug Court Program through the issuance of a one-year Blanket Purchase Agreement (BPA) for the period beginning October 1, 2020 and ending September 30, 2021. Drug Court treatment services typically include the following: urine collection, individual substance abuse assessments, individual and group substance abuse treatment, structured educational classes relative to drug and/or alcohol abuse, as well as transportation for participants to the treatment site. Providers will be required to demonstrate their ability to avail their services to Drug Court participants in Ohio, Hancock, Marshall, and Wetzel counties in West Virginia, and the general surrounding areas.

Interested treatment providers must respond timely to solicitation deadlines and clearly show that (1) they can provide services, (2) such services will be provided by certified, licensed professionals with experience in such treatment, and (3) prices of such treatment shall be as low as or lower than those charged to the treatment provider's most favored customer for comparable quantities under similar terms and conditions.

Letters of interest must include the types of services the agency is able to provide and must be received on or before 12:00 noon on Tuesday, October 13, 2020.
